

**FIREARM LICENSING AUTHORITY**  
**Procedure For Replacement Of Defective Firearm**  
**as at Monday October 9, 2006**



1. Applicant visits Firearm Dealer, collects and completes the Request for Replacement of Defective Firearm Form. Applicant can also download form from the FLA's website at [www.fla.gov.jm](http://www.fla.gov.jm) .
2. Applicant submits form, Firearm and Firearm Booklet to the Firearm Dealer.
3. Firearm Dealer's Armourer or Private Armourer examines Firearm and if firearm is found to be:
  - a. Defective beyond economic repair or
  - b. If repaired, its efficiency cannot be guaranteedcompletes, signs and stamps the relevant section of the Form.
4. Firearm is placed in irrevocable safekeeping by the Dealer for collection by the Firearm Licensing Authority.
5. Firearm Licensing Authority processes request.
